FAR NORTH SPIRITS HALLOCK, MINNESOTA

Located in Hallock, Minnesota (population 981), Far North Spirits is the northernmost distillery in the contiguous United States. Located 25 miles from the Canadian border, this small craft distillery is making a serious name for itself in the sustainable farming, distillation and aging of single varietal whiskey.

> The great wines of the world are inextricably tied to the variety of the grapes from which they are made. However, for whiskeys, which are fermented and distilled from grains, that varietal information and the tie to the agriculture behind it is often severed. Grain is the foundation upon which all whiskey is built. Far North produces exceptional whiskey because it's made from exceptional, estate-grown varieties of grain and heirloom corn. Like their estate winery counterparts, Far North's focus on varietals results in complex and distinct flavors in the finished spirit.

Maintaining over 50 acres of pollinator habitat and implementing pollinator best management practices, Far North Spirits is the only distillery in the country to be certified by the Pollinator Partnership as a Bee Friendly Farm.

FAR NORTH SPIRITS

OFFERINGS AVAILABLE

BODALEN BOURBON

Aged in Minnesota-made oak barrels for 18 months. Bødalen is named for an idyllic Norwegian valley on the edge of a massive glacier. The mash bill is 60% heirloom corn, 30% Hazlet rye and 10% malt barley.

ROKNAR RYE COGNAC CASK - LIMITED RELEASE

Aged for 16 months in 15-gallon charred oak barrels and finished in Cognac casks. With a mash bill of 80% rye, 10% corn and 10% malt barley, Far North aims to establish MINNESOTA RYE as a regional style in the spirit of Pennsylvania and Maryland-style ryes.

ROKNAR STRAIGHT RYE

Aged for 18 months in 15-gallon charred oak barrels. This provenance-driven, single estate rye whiskey is made entirely in Northern Minnesota. Distilled from estate grown Hazlet winter rye, with 5% of the rye custom malted nearby in Fisher, MN at Vertical Malt.

ROKNAR BONDED RYE - LIMITED RELEASE

Aged for a minimum of 4 years in 53-gallon charred oak barrels and bottled at 100 proof. With a mash bill of 80% rye, 10% corn and 10% malt barley, Far North aims to establish MINNESOTA RYE as a regional style in the spirit of Pennsylvania and Maryland-style ryes.

ROKNAR RYE SAUTERNES CASK - LIMITED RELEASE

Aged for 16 months in 15-gallon charred oak barrels and finished in Sauternes wine casks. Sauternes is a sweet and complex white wine from the Bordeaux region of France. Sauternes casks are extremely rare and a superb cask for finishing rye whiskey.

ROKNAR MARYLAND STYLE RYE – LIMITED RELEASE

Made from 65% Hazlet rye, 25% heirloom corn, and 10% malt barley, Roknar Maryland-style is aged just shy of two years in Minnesota-made barrels. The recipe is based upon George Washington's original mash bill from his distillery at Mount Vernon. Maryland-style rye was known as the "American gentleman's whiskey" for its softer, sweeter flavor profile from the additional corn.

CH is Chicago's leading artisan spirits producer with an extensive portfolio including the only organic vodka made from Illinois grain and a variety of core and specialty spirits. Founded in 2013, the name CH refers to the great city of Chicago and the fundamental compounds in alcohol, Carbon and Hydrogen.

In September 2018, CH Distillery purchased Carl Jeppson Company and Jeppson's Malört. Through the decades, Jeppson's Malört has been thought of as rite of passage or a hangover cure. For many Chicagoans, Malört is a drink that has helped define the Chicago bar experience.

Kings County Distillery is New York City's oldest and largest whiskey distillery. Founded in 2010, Kings County makes handmade bourbon, rye, and other whiskeys out of the 123-year-old Paymaster Building in Brooklyn's Navy Yard. They blend distilling practices from a variety of cultures into creative whiskeys that remain traditional while defying convention, using Scottish copper pot stills, open fermentation, and local non-GMO grains to make American whiskeys that expand the category.

Their craftsmanship and award-winning whiskeys have been praised by the New York Times, Wine & Spirits Magazine, and Whisky Advocate. Kings County was named "Distillery of the Year" in 2016 from the American Distilling Institute and then again, named "Distillery of the Year" in 2023 by the New Orleans Spirits Competition.

Kings County Distillery's contribution to the resurgence of craft distillation in New York City has made it a prominent fixture in the world of artisanal spirits, and it continues to attract new whiskey enthusiasts with every release.

BLENDED BOURBON

Each batch of the blended bourbon will contain a unique combination of aged whiskeys from inventory. This is a whiskey for every occasion: complex enough for daily sipping, robust enough for craft cocktails and highballs, yet approachable enough to accompany a cold beer. 86 proof

STRAIGHT BOURBON

This bourbon uses 80% New York organic corn and 20% English Golden Promise barley for a high-malt recipe that forgoes the wheat or rye typical of Kentucky bourbons. The mash is then double pot distilled and aged in a variety of new charred oak barrels between 3 and 6 years. 90 proof

PEATED BOURBON

The malt used in this peated bourbon was grown and kilned in Scotland. It's a hybrid whiskey of the two traditions: the high-corn mashbill and newbarrel aging produce a spirit that is unmistakably bourbon, while notes of barbecue and campfire smoke linger long after the sip. 90 proof

BOTTLED-IN-BOND BOURBON

At 6.5 years, this Bottled-in-Bond Bourbon is KCD's oldest ever blend of Bonded whiskey and the first in their history to exclusively utilize whiskey aged in standard-format cooperage. Notes of toasted cinnamon and fully integrated oak leads into a medley of ripe berry fruits, thick caramel. 100 proof

The result is a unique, very full-flavored whiskey that typically comes in between 105 - 115 proof. Each batch is a blend of 5 - 10 barrels, is hand labeled, numbered and individually proofed.

STRAIGHT BOURBON SINGLE BARREL

Every barrel of bourbon has an individual personality. Sometimes we find one with such a distinct flavor, it demands its own attention. We bottle these barrels as a unique batch, uncut and unfiltered, allowing you to enjoy an unrivaled single barrel bourbon.

STRAIGHT BOURBON WHEATED

This wheated bourbon recipe features local white corn, red winter wheat and malt. Soft, gentle wheat bread flavors are complimented by robust oak and brown sugar notes from the barrel. As an uncut and unfiltered barrel proof bourbon, this is a fantastic pour neat or on the rocks.

The first bottled-in-bond whiskey made in Minnesota since before prohibition. Mash bill: 55% corn, 35% wheat and 10 % malted barley. Made from Minnesota grains, distilled in Tattersall's NE Minneapolis distillery, and aged for over 4 years in Minnesota white oak barrels. Aromas of dulce de leche and fresh baked cherry pie combined with flavors of graham cracker and stone fruit. Subtle oak tannins round out the smooth finish. A perfectly smooth sipper.

STRAIGHT RYE WHISKEY

Single-farm sourced rye from a friend's farm in Cambridge, Minnesota. This whiskey uses 85% AC Hazlet rye varietal with 15% malted rye. Mashed, fermented, and twice-distilled through a pot still. Aged in on-site barrel room for a minimum of 2 years. Vanilla, maple, and mellow oak on the nose. Robust and peppery on the palate with light cherry notes. Lingering caramel finish.

ESPY HOUSE SPIRITS BEDFORD, PENINSYLVANIA

The Espy House, built of stone in 1771, is a national historic landmark and was a hot spot of activity in Pennsylvania during the American revolution. In 1794, President George Washington used the house as his base of operations to help calm a local uprising during the whiskey rebellion of 1794.

In 1794, congress repealed a tax on distilled spirits, but replaced it with a new one causing the onset of what was later known as the "whiskey rebellion." The locals in western Pennsylvania were unceremoniously informed that the new tax would be collected, by force if necessary. They felt the tax was unfair and organized the first rebellion against the new United States government. George Washington mobilized 12,950 troops from eastern Pennsylvania, Virginia, Maryland, and New Jersey under General Harry Lee, with the intent on quelling the rebellion and asserting the government's authority to make laws and enforce them. The rebellion ended with only minor confrontation and no loss of life.

When you take a sip of Espy House Bourbon, you're taking a journey that started over 250 years ago at a time when our country was just being formed. The American Revolution was in full-swing and the new American government was testing their new laws. The Espy House was at the center of it all.

CLASSIC RYE

This classic recipe (80% rye, 15% barley malt, 5% rye malt) features only rye grain and malt to deliver a pure expression of Pennsylvania Rye Whiskey. Barrel aging for least six months in charred, new oak quarter casks allows the genuine rye flavor to evolve quickly. As a result, the small batch whiskey is ensured of reaching the right balance of complexity and smoothness. It delivers the up-front spice while finishing with a full, round mouthfeel.

BONDED RYE

This is a whiskey of integrity that should be tasted in its full, bond-certified glory. A blend of five specifically selected barrels, distilled in the same season, were used to blend this spirit, resulting in deep, rich, concentrated flavor. After maturing in these barrels for 5 years, the emerging whiskey is a classic Pre-Prohibition Pennsylvania Bottled in Bond.

STRAIGHT RYE

The first Straight Rye made in Pennsylvania in over 25 years, this delicious whiskey is distilled farm-to-bottle in Pennsylvania with locally harvested grain and aged for a minimum of four years. The classic Pre-Prohibition flavor profile is the result of time-tested distilling methods and painstaking attention to detail.

PORT FINISH RYE

Rich port wine flavor meets genuine rye spice as we add another unique double finish rye to the ranks with our Port Wine Finish Rye. This rye is double finished for an additional three months in separate barrels which previously contained port wine, made with red grapes and known for a fruity, pleasant sweetness.

VERMOUTH FINISH RYE

For this modern classic Vermouth Finish Rye, we've selected casks previously inhabited by Quady Winery's Vya Sweet Vermouth to create an amazing double finish rye. The process takes our classic rye, already matured for at least six months, and ages for an additional three months in select vermouth barrels. The warm, balanced flavor of American vermouth coupled with our smooth, spicy rye delivers an exceptional nose with a distinctive taste and character all its own.

Each bottle bears the distinction of a designated barrel and batch number, and the signature of our esteemed Female Master Destiladora, Zandra Gomez.

SINGLE BARREL ANEJO TEQUILA

The Single Barrel Añejo presents itself with unwavering authenticity in its cask strength bottling. The distillate embarks on a transformation, maturing initially within a singular American White Oak cask for a span of 15.5 months. This journey concludes with a refined touch as it rests within a sole French Oak cask for an additional 2.5 months, embodying the essence of a true single barrel, single finish Tequila – an unblended masterpiece. Rich flavors of butterscotch and dark caramel coat the palate, alongside an intense wave of toasted vanilla and charred oak. The higher alcohol content at cask strength intensifies the flavor profile, adding depth and complexity. Robust notes of dark chocolate, black cherries, and black pepper emerge, contributing to a complex and satisfying taste experience.

Each bottle bears the distinction of a designated barrel and batch number, showcasing the ABV, and the signature of our esteemed Female Master Destiladora, Zandra Gomez. The culmination of these efforts spans a total aging period of 18 months, each moment a testament to the meticulous dedication invested in crafting this prized spirit.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long does the order/production process take?

All orders will be executed on a "First Come First Served" basis. The amount of time required to produce a barrel of whiskey will vary by distillery. Due to the small batch, craft and size of the gems in our spirits portfolio, it is on a case-by-case basis.

Can I be there when my whiskey is being bottled?

Yes! We can make arrangements for you to visit the distillery depending on your specific situation. During part or the whole production period, we will directly involve you in the status and processing of your barrel. A detailed production schedule will be provided upon signing the contract. If for whatever reason you cannot be there during the production period, we will make sure to take pictures/video of the entire process and send them to you.

Can I personalize the bottles of whiskey from my barrel?

Yes, but some restrictions apply. If there is a need for a different presentation, a different label or bottle then additional expenses may apply. We have shifted to different options per customer in the past with no problems.

Are other types of spirits available in the private barrel program?

While bourbon and rye whiskey are the most requested products for our private barrel program, other types of spirits such as tequila, mezcal, rum, gin, or vodka, might also be available depending on the manufacturer's inventory. We can certainly explore the options of these selections if desired. Personalization is a huge benefit to the modern-day consumer, so the more opportunity you have to do this, the better. It's a great opportunity to build brand partnerships, foster unique marketing avenues, and reinforce the message that your customers will always find something special at your store, bar or restaurant.
